MACA Crushing specialises in crushing, screening, and mineral processing service solutions. We construct, build, commission projects, and maintain an extensive fleet of mobile and fixed plant and machinery.

**Our skilled teams provide safe, innovative, and efficient services for peak production for our clients across different mineral ores.**

From design to construction and delivery, our material handling experts combine their knowledge to deliver optimal mineral processing solutions, including direct shipped ores (DSO), construction aggregates, sands and rail ballasts, and recycling material such as recycled aggregated pavement (RAP).

With a comprehensive inventory of track-mounted mobile and fixed crushing, screening, and stacking equipment, we are well positioned to supply services in the fields of DSO ores and aggregates. We pride ourselves on exceeding production targets, with our mobile plants processing up to 350 - 650 tonnes per hour, and our fixed plants handling up to 2500 tonnes per hour.
