MACA Mining specialises in drill and blast, load and haul, and materials handling services and is backed by a large fleet of high-quality plant and equipment.

We specialise in open-cut mining across a range of commodities, including iron ore, nickel, gold, lead, and, lithium.

#### **AUTONOMOUS HAULAGE SOLUTIONS**

In early 2022, MACA and its technology partners, Safe AI and Position Partners, advanced autonomous haulage with the successful completion of a six month proof of concept trial.

The trial involved the retrofit of an existing 181t haul truck with autonomous hardware and software. The technology can be retrofitted to most types of equipment and can therefore be quickly implemented across a site or fleet.

This next generation of autonomy has the potential to increase productivity and lower operating costs through more efficient movements which will reduce maintenance, tyre wear and fuel consumption requirements to provide our clients with a tailored solution at a quantifiable cost, with minimal mobilisation and lead time.





## **MACA CRUSHING**

MACA Crushing specialises in crushing, screening, and mineral processing service solutions.

We construct, build, commission projects, and maintain an extensive fleet of mobile and fixed plant and machinery.

Our skilled teams provide safe, innovative, and efficient services for peak production for our clients across different mineral ores. From design to construction and delivery, our material handling experts combine their knowledge to deliver optimal mineral processing solutions, including direct shipped ores (DSO), construction aggregates, sands and rail ballasts, and recycling material such as recycled aggregated pavement (RAP).


